ELECTIONS TO THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF AIFTP FOR THE TERM 2026 AND 2027

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STRICT COMPLIANCE BY THE CANDIDATES DURING POLLING

1. **Candidates** must be personally present during polling times on 12.12.2025 at the polling venue.
2. Candidates who cannot be personally present on account of **exception circumstances** may seek **exemption** from the Chief Election Officer in writing, 24 hours in advance, which may be granted by the Chief Election Officer at her discretion.
3. Candidates to check their name and serial number on the Ballot Paper pasted outside Polling Station 1 (One) hour prior to Commencement of Polling (OGM).
4. Canvassing on **individual basis is permitted. Candidates are advised to go through Rule 9 of Election Code of Conduct of AIFTP.**
5. Canvassing cannot be done in and around polling area.
6. Canvassing in groups is not permitted by sending Panel on different WhatsApp groups.
7. Candidates cannot form panels for voting by sending SMS/WhatsApp Messages.
8. Candidates cannot accompany voters to the Polling area.
9. Each Candidate can nominate one **representative** (who should be a member of AIFTP) in writing to the Chief Election Officer at least 1 (One) hour prior to the start of OGM who shall represent him at the time of counting.
10. Candidates shall not **interfere with the polling process either directly or indirectly cannot speak or argue with any of the Polling Officers and/or Volunteers designated by the Chief Election Officer or the Election Officer's during Election Process.**
11. Any candidate/s found violating the Election Code of Conduct and Rules of the AIFTP and / or the above instructions shall be liable for **immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Chief Election Officer.**

12. Any complaint in regard to the Election Process or discrepancies shall be brought to the notice of the Chief Election Officer only in writing.
13. Only one manifesto or appeal or circular or pamphlet (whether in electronic, digital or physical form including by way of SMS or any other means) seeking support of his / her candidature shall be issued by the contesting candidate or his / her authorised representative/s in relation to the election during the period from the date of issue of final list of valid nominations to the candidates. It is made clear that other than the contesting candidate or his / her authorised representative/s, no other person or member shall, send or forward, any manifesto or appeal or circular or pamphlet (whether in electronic, digital or physical form including by way of SMS or any other means) seeking support of his / her candidature. Such manifesto or appeal or circular or pamphlet shall not contain any information on the basis / lines of religion / caste / creed / community / political or spiritual leadership or on any other sectoral lines / basis; Such manifesto or appeal or circular or pamphlet shall not carry information / message or words which cause damage or disrepute to any other contesting candidate or to the Federation.
- 14. It is hereby informed that in the ensuing election at Bengaluru, the personal presence of the respective candidates is dispensed with only if there is a disruption of Indigo flights in their city.**
15. Decisions given by the Chief Election Officer shall be final and binding on all.
